TRIP TIPS:

- ◆ **Climate – Average temperature for month of August is 78 degrees high/56 degrees low.**
- ◆ **During our stay, you will be on the go please make sure you wear comfortable shoes.**
- ◆ **You are welcome to bring board and card games to share with group – we will have social time as schedule permits.**
- ◆ **Check your watch – TRAVERSE CITY MICHIGAN IS ON EASTERN STANDARD TIME ZONE. Activities are scheduled according to this time zone.**
- ◆ **Don't forget your pets – review the listed pet sitters or ask the campground if there are pet sitters available at or near the campground.**
- ◆ **Please complete the EMERGENCY CARD and return it to the registration table upon receipt of your registration packet. Remember to list if you are having a birthday or anniversary during our rally.**
- ◆ **Remember to wear your NAME BADGE when we gather for group activities.**
- ◆ **Activity tickets are located behind the men's name badge or 1st person listed on the roster and used when activities do not require a ticket. Bus monitor will take up your ticket once you are seated on the bus.**
- ◆ **DRESS CODE for Williamsburg Dinner Theater is Casual, recommended no torn jeans, shorts, tank tops, flip flops, etc.). DRESS CODE for the Wine Tour and Dinner is Business Casual (no jeans, shorts, tank tops, flip flops, etc.)**
- ◆ **Bus seating – The first 2 seats NOT behind the bus driver are reserved for our attendees who are registered in “handicapped” parking or who have trouble walking. These seats will be marked with a sign designating reserved for handicapped. If you occupy these seats you should be the LAST to get off the bus so you have ample time. The first 2 seats behind the bus driver are reserved for the Bus Monitor and will be marked with a card designating reserved for bus monitor.**

TRANSPORTATION:

- **Bus pick up for scheduled activities will be reviewed at welcome orientation.**
- **We are using a SCHOOL BUS operated by the campground for our options. The cost is minimal compared to what it would cost to rent a charter bus. It allows us to offer you options at a very reasonable price. For those of you who have chosen to participate in the options and do not want to ride the school bus, you may drive and follow the bus or if you prefer to cancel the option, please let me know as soon as possible in order to obtain a refund.**
- **Our dinner on Monday evening, August 23, 2010, will be a car caravan to the location a short distance away. Everyone is invited to attend the dinner, as it is our Welcome Dinner and Entertainment sponsored by Gulf Stream Coach.**
