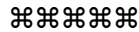

On The Road To A Healthy Lifestyle

From RVIA News –Reston VA “Take two days and see me in the morning.” That’s one doctor’s advice for a healthy lifestyle.

Michael Suk, M.D., has a simple, fun and powerful message: people should pursue outdoor activities to help reduce obesity and stress. This is also the recommendation of the Recreation Vehicle Industry Association (RVIA).

The health-related benefits of recreation vehicle (RV) travel strongly reflects Dr. Suk’s message. Many RV owners are already on the road to a healthy lifestyle, taking advantage of all the activities that the outdoors has to offer. In RVIA’s recent Campfire Canvass survey of RV owners, almost 70 percent said they were more physically active on RV trips than on other vacations.

There is a wide range of campgrounds available to RV owners or renter, offering a variety of outdoor activities. Dr Suk says that along with hiking, biking, or swimming, “RV campgrounds are great places to try new activities like kayaking, canoeing, and even swinging from a tree.”
